



Using just soap, water and some rubbing colourful sheep's wool fibres are transformed into magic felted balls.



Cut open to reveal a beautiful swirly pattern inside. The pattern is always symmetrical. A moment of awe and wonder!



One of the simplest and most effective projects. This is especially good for younger children. As the children get older they make more firmly felted balls and the embellishments become more complex. The mini-beasts can become characters in stories, they can be used as puppets and much more.
